Hamilton Abuse Intervention Project (HAIP) is committed to respect for and observance of human rights and fundamental freedoms. HAIP promotes the vision of the Sanctity of Women and the Divinity of Children. The agency was established to assist in the coordination of services provided by criminal justice agencies and key community agencies, which might reduce the levels of violence experienced by women and their children.

HAIP runs a number of programmes but funding from the Small Grants Fund is targeted towards the Youth Programmes. The children and young people attending the programmes are aged between 12 and 17. HAIP endeavours to work with the children to raise their awareness on domestic violence without them having to own or feel responsible for the violence in their lives. The organisations works with schools and individuals as well as parents and whanau to acheieve this goal.
